This function is accessible only by the administrator of the database SPM.

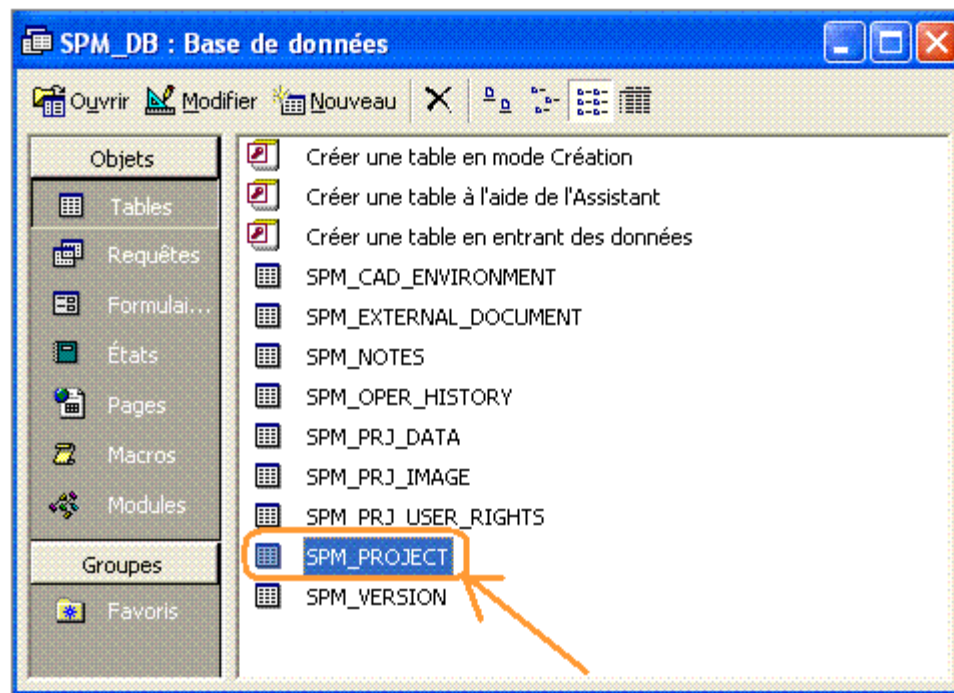
The administrator of the database SPM in format Access can modify this statute by the medium of Microsoft Access.

Precaution :

Ensure that the project has been really deleted from the local disk of the User.

Operational mode :

1. Open the database of SPM_DB.MDB with MS Access.
2. Open the table SPM_PROJET :



3. Search the column "NAME_PRJ" and the corresponding line of the project :
